The Board of Trustees of the Aromas-San Juan Unified School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee ("CBOC") for the oversight of the District's Measure M Facilities Bond program.

Proposition 39 Bond Election

On March 3, 2020, voters residing within the Aromas-San Juan Unified School District passed Measure M. Measure M is a \$4.2 million bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools. Proposition 39 required a 55% supermajority for approval; Measure M was passed by 57.42%.

Establishment of a Citizens' Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Aromas-San Juan Unified School District Board of Trustees appoint a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to work with the District.

Committee Responsibilities

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure M bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure M bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure M; and
- Present to the Board of Trustees in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure M bond proceeds.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Board of Trustees from applications submitted to the District.

Time Commitment and Term

Each member shall serve a term of two (2) years, commencing on the date of appointment by the Board of Trustees. No member may serve more than three (3) consecutive terms.
