What does virtual at home Instruction look like at VVHS?

- 1) Students who choose virtual online instruction through the district Google survey will be issued Chromebooks via drive through pick up at OH Herman Middle School on Friday, August 14, 4pm – 7pm.
- 2) Virtual student schedules will follow the same bell schedule as in person on campus instruction.
- 3) Virtual students will use their Chromebooks to log into their teacher's Google classroom and live streamed Google meet at the beginning of each of their classes.
- 4) A virtual student is counted virtually "Present" for that period if they are logged into their teacher's Google meet and Google classroom at the beginning of their class period and remains logged in for the duration of that period.
- 5) If a student is not logged into their Google meet and Google classroom when the teacher takes attendance at the start of the period, the student will be counted absent.
- 6) TEA requires that all virtual students meet the same compulsory attendance requirements as on campus students. Failure to meet minimum attendance requirements will result in loss of credit.

Example:

1st period (7:50am – 8:37am):

- 1) Student uses Chromebook and successfully logs into their 1st period teacher's Google meet and Google classroom by 7:50am.
- 2) 1st period teacher sees student's presence online for their 1st period class and marks the student present for 1st period. (If teacher does not see the student's presence online, the student is counted absent.)
- 3) 1st period teacher live streams the instruction for that classroom through their Google meet and Google classroom while both in class and virtual students receive the same instruction and complete the required assignments using Chromebook at the same time.

Breakfast Break (8:37am – 8:50am)

- 1) On campus students receive breakfast in the classroom.
- 2) Virtual students take a break and return to their Chromebook in time to log into their 2nd period teacher's Google meet and Google classroom.

2nd Period (8:51am-9:45am):

- 1) Student uses Chromebook and successfully logs into their 2nd period teacher's Google meet and Google classroom by 8:56am.
- 2) 2nd period teacher sees student's presence online for their 2nd period class and marks the student present for 2nd period. (If teacher does not see the student's presence online, the student is counted absent.)

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- 3) 2nd period teacher live streams the instruction for that classroom through their Google meet and Google classroom while both in class and virtual students receive the same instruction and complete the required assignments using Chromebook at the same time.

Passing Period (9:45am – 9:49am):

- 1) Bell rings for students to go to 3rd period. While on campus students change classrooms, the virtual student takes a quick break and is back on their Chromebook and logged into their 3rd period teacher's Google meet and Google classroom at the start of 3rd period.

3rd Period (9:49am – 10:36am):

- 1) Student uses Chromebook and successfully logs into their 3rd period teacher's Google meet and Google classroom by 9:49am.
- 2) 3rd period teacher sees student's presence online for their 3rd period class and marks the student present for 3rd period. (If teacher does not see the student's presence online, the student is counted absent.)
- 3) 3rd period teacher live streams the instruction for that classroom through their Google meet and Google classroom while both in class and virtual students receive the same instruction and complete the required assignments using Chromebook at the same time.

Passing Period (10:36am – 10:40am):

- 1) Bell rings for students to go to 4th period. While on campus students change classrooms, the virtual student takes a quick break and is back on their Chromebook and logged into their 4th period teacher's Google meet and Google classroom at the start of 4th period.

4th Period (10:40am – 11:27am):

- 1) Student uses Chromebook and successfully logs into their 4th period teacher's Google meet and Google classroom by 10:40am.
- 2) 4th period teacher sees student's presence online for their 4th period class and marks the student present for 4th period. (If teacher does not see the student's presence online, the student is counted absent.)
- 3) 4th period teacher live streams the instruction for that classroom through their Google meet and Google classroom while both in class and virtual students receive the same instruction and complete the required assignments using Chromebook at the same time.

This process repeats itself for 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th periods following the 2020-2021 VVHS Bell Schedule included in this correspondence.

Each student's 4th or 5th period teacher will communicate what period each virtual student is assigned to have lunch.
