- Grades 6-12: Middle and High School Councils

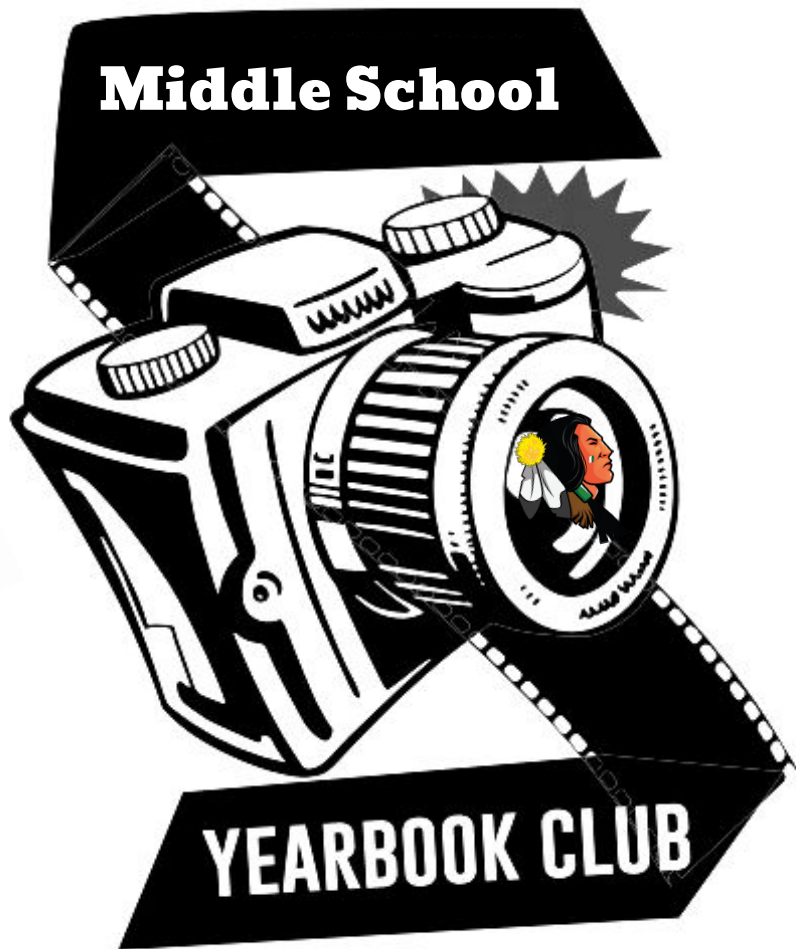
How?
