Contest Management – Covid-19

The Indiana High School Athletic Association announced July 29 that high school fall sports are on track to proceed as planned. Gov. Eric Holcomb announced Wednesday, July 29, the state of Indiana will remain in Stage 4.5 until Thursday, Aug. 27. Our plans will comply with state, local, federal and IHSA guidelines

All-Sports Passes will not be sold for the fall sports season.

- **August 15 through August 27 – Admission will be limited to family members of players and essential personnel.** This will include the sports of football, volleyball, and soccer and tennis. Face coverings will be required and social distancing expected. There will be a limited number of tickets available at each home event for Milan High School students and sold at school through the athletic office. Football scrimmage on August 15th will be for players and coaches only. **NO SPECTATORS FOR THE SCRIMMAGE!**
- **Beginning August 28 –** Admission guidelines to be determined based on State of Indiana, Indiana DOE and IHSA guidance and capacity restrictions at the time.
- **VOLLEYBALL**-capacity will be maximum of 250. Masks are required at all times. Social distancing (6 feet) in common areas, including the bleachers and standing room areas are required.
- **FOOTBALL** - Visiting spectators will be directed to South Entrance and the home crowd will use the North Entrance. Both entrances will be clearly marked. Fans are only allowed to use the bleachers for their school. The visiting team will occupy the visitors' bleachers (North side) and the home team will use the home bleachers (South side). Those choosing to social distance more than bleacher space allows will be permitted to stand along the fence line in the facility. Visitors' bleachers will have a capacity of 168; home bleachers will have capacity of 250. Fans must social distance and wear masks upon entering the area.
- When attending football games, identifiable markings will define social distancing when waiting in lines for concessions and restrooms. Each school will have a designated concession stand line. Those will be clearly marked "Milan" and "Visitors". Milan fans will use restrooms located inside door U and Visitors will use restrooms by door M.
- Football ticket vouchers will be given to each athlete prior to selling tickets at the door. Tickets will be limited to maximum capacity set out by county health dept.
- **SOCCKER**- Spectators will be limited to family members of players. Each family will sit in bag chairs along the West side of the field. Families will social distance and wear masks at all times.
- Students grade 8 and under will be required to sit with parents or family members. Students/children will not be allowed to roam freely at the venue during the contest. (When applicable)
- Students in grades 9-12 attending the game will be seated in a designated area (socially distanced) or be required to sit with parents/family members.
