Chromebook 1:1 Program

We are proud to provide our students with one-to-one Chromebooks, powerful tools that facilitate and enhance their learning experience. To ensure a smooth process and to maintain the integrity of this initiative, we have established certain eligibility criteria for students to qualify for the Chromebook loan program. Please review the following requirements carefully

1. **Enrollment at Noble Schools:** Students must be actively enrolled and attending Noble Schools to be eligible for the Chromebook loan program.
2. **Agreement to Loan Terms and Responsibilities:** It is essential that all students and parents/guardians agree to the terms and conditions outlined in the loan agreement, as well as the respective Parent/Guardian and Student responsibilities. This commitment helps us foster a sense of shared responsibility for the devices.
3. **Clearance of Outstanding Fees:** Students seeking a Chromebook loan must not have any outstanding Chromebook repair or replacement fees. Ensuring a clean record helps us manage the loan program more effectively.
4. **One Chromebook Per Student:** To ensure equitable distribution and fair access to all students, only one Chromebook can be loaned to each student.

Should you meet the above eligibility criteria, we encourage you to apply for the School Issued Chromebook loan program. Our aim is to empower our students with the right tools for their academic success while fostering a collaborative and engaging learning environment. Chromebook Loan Agreement (Grades 4 - 12)

One Chromebook and one power adapter are being loaned to the above student and to the student's parents or legal guardians (collectively the "Borrower") and are in good working order. It is Borrower's responsibility to care for the Equipment and ensure that it is kept in a safe environment.

- This Equipment is and at all times remains the property of Independent School District No. 40 of Cleveland County, Oklahoma, a/k/a Noble Public Schools (the "District") and is loaned to the student for educational purposes for the academic school year.
- Students may not deface or destroy this Equipment in any way.
- Inappropriate use of the Equipment or use in violation of the District's Acceptable Use Policy may result in the student losing his/her right to use the Equipment.
- The Equipment must be returned to the District when requested, at the end of the academic school year, or sooner if the student withdraws from Noble Public Schools prior to the end of the school year.
- The Equipment may be used by Borrower only for non-commercial purposes, in accordance with the Policies and Rules Regarding Computer Use.
- The District's Acceptable Use Policy, Board Policy, the Noble Public Schools Student Handbook, and all applicable local, state, and federal laws, rules, and regulations will apply.
- The borrower may not install or use any software other than software owned or approved by the District and made available to Borrower.
- Borrower agrees not to copy or make any unauthorized use of or modifications of such software or to use such software in any way which violates the software license. Borrower agrees to indemnify the District for any claims arising from Borrower's misuse of the Equipment, including but not limited to claims alleging infringement of copyright or other intellectual property rights.
- The District is not responsible for any computer or electronic viruses that may be transferred to or from Borrower's data storage medium and Borrower agrees to use Borrower's best efforts to ensure that the Equipment is not damaged or rendered inoperable by any such electronic virus while in Borrower's possession.
- Borrower acknowledges and agrees that Borrower's use of the Equipment is a privilege and that by entering into this Agreement, Borrower acknowledges Borrower's responsibility to protect and safeguard the Equipment and to return the same in good condition and repair.
- The Equipment is the property of the District and must be returned at the end of the online learning period in good working condition.
- The Borrower is responsible for any damage to the Equipment and for loss or failure to return the Equipment.
- Any damage beyond normal wear and tear will be charged to the parent/student.
- Please report any loss, damage, or theft immediately to the school site.
- Replacement or repair costs are as follows:
 - Screen Replacement: \$150
 - Chromebook Charger: \$40 if ordered from the school or you can order a generic charger from Amazon at <https://amzn.to/3yYnYRh>
 - Entire Chromebook Replacement: \$400.
- Students will not be issued a loaner device or receive the repaired device back until either:
 - A payment plan has been set up with the district, and at least one payment has been made.
 - The repair cost or replacement value has been paid in full.
