

In Seneca County, there are a variety of health centers, doctor's offices, Urgent Care centers, and two nearby hospitals (Geneva General and Cayuga Medical Center) that offer COVID-19 testing within a reasonable drive. As of mid-July 2020, active testing sites are indicated in blue on the map below, with Ovid (the site of our MSHS building) shown in red.



COVID-19 Testing Responsibility and Protocols

All COVID-19 testing results for residents of Seneca County are sent to the Seneca County Department of Health for tracking purposes, and the responsibility for oversight of testing in general in the county falls to Health Director Vickie Swinehart, and the staff at Seneca County DOH. The following is the decision matrix utilized by Seneca County DOH:



Person is COV+ (Symptomatic)

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Symptomatic and is **NOT** a nursing home employee

Isolation for <u>10 days</u> from start of symptoms, *AND* must be 3 days fever free without medication, *and* improvement of resp issues to be released.

Person is COV+ (Symptomatic)

Symptomatic and is also a nursing home employee

Isolation for <u>14 days</u> from start of symptoms, *AND* 3 days fever free without medication, *and* improvement of resp issues to be released. Person is COV+ (Asymptomatic) Asymptomatic and <u>NOT</u> a nursing home employee Isolation for <u>10 days</u> from date of test AND
continuation of NO symptoms.

Person is COV+ (Asymptomatic) Asymptomatic and is <u>also a nursing home employee</u>

Isolation for <u>14 days</u> from date of test *AND* continuation of NO symptoms.
