## **Remote Learning**

Remote learning may occur during any of our three instructional delivery models. Some families may select to participate in remote learning even though in-person instruction is available. Those students would attend their regular class / classes virtually via Google Meet Monday-Friday.

If the District were to be in a Hybrid model, students would attend their class virtually on the days they are not scheduled to be present in school.

It is possible the District may be forced to implement a full virtual model. In that event, students at the Jr./Sr. High, will attend each class virtually through Google Meet. Their virtual classes will follow the inperson bell schedule and attendance will be taken every period.

The District will provide every student with a Chromebook to ensure continuity of instruction and to close any inequity gaps. The District surveyed families regarding their internet connectivity and reliability and we are prepared assist those families that are unable to secure an internet connection during a period of time their child is participating in remote learning.

Regardless of the mode of instructional delivery (in-person, virtual or hybrid) our students will receive regular substantive interaction from their teachers. If students encounter problems with any of the remote options, parents and students can e-mail staff directly with any questions or concerns. In addition, a support message hotline has been set up to assist families throughout the duration of the pandemic at 585-658-5010. If broadband is not available and cellular hotspots cannot pick up a signal at a home, the District will provide that student with a thumb drive each day.
