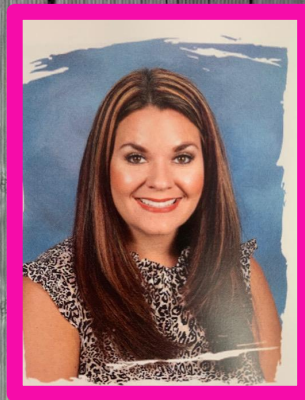

# ATTENDANCE

- Although we are starting the year off virtually, attendance will be taken and it is mandatory.

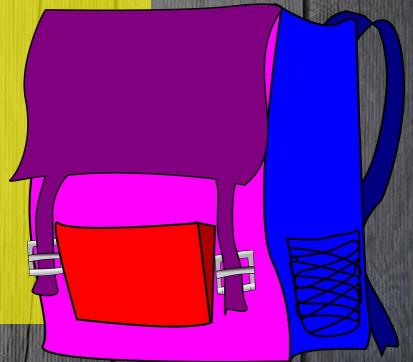

# ELA Learning Expectations

- Recognize and read all 107 1<sup>st</sup> grade sight words.
- Identify story elements (characters, setting(s), problem, solution, beginning, middle, and end).
- Retell a story using details from the text.
- Compare and Contrast books, characters, etc.
- Identify text features in Fiction and Non-fiction books.
- Write Narratives, Opinion and Sequenced pieces with details.





# Math Learning Expectations



- Understand Place Value (tens and ones)
- Collect & Interpret data (Graphing)
- Add and subtract within 20 (Ex.  $9 + 5 = \underline{\quad}$ )
- Add and subtract double digits without regrouping (Ex.  $32 + 46 = \underline{\quad}$ )
- Solve addition and subtraction story problems.
- Recognize & label 2D and 3D shapes with their attributes.
- Solve problems with 3 addends within 20. (Ex.  $4 + 4 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$ ).
- Tell time to the hour and half hour.
- Understand Fact families
- Identify Greater than, Less than and Equal to when looking at numbers and equations.

# Developmental Milestones

## Physical Development

- Have improved hand-eye coordination for things like tying shoelaces
- Neat handwriting
- Can run, hop, skip, and jump
- Can throw and kick a ball, and catch it with both hands
- Can copy shapes and letters
- Can tie shoes and button and zip independently

## Cognitive Development

- Learn from what they hear and read—not just from what they see and do
- Can read several sight words (words they see frequently and can read without sounding out) and sound out other words
- Begin to have a better sense of time, understanding increments of time, days, weeks, months, and seasons
- Predict what comes next in a pattern, as well as recognize and create their own patterns
