## 4TH GRADE

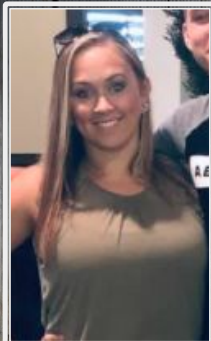

## expectations

# ATTENDANCE

Although we are starting the year off virtually, attendance is a requirement. Attendance will be taken daily Monday through Thursday. Attendance will be collected by a daily roll call on class dojo. We understand that everyone may not be able to be logged in at the designated class times however completion of assignments is required.

- \*If a child misses 3 consecutive days social workers/ guidance counselors will make contact.
- \* 10 consecutive absences will result in school drop-out.

# Virtual Learning



School Computer & Email Login: This will give you access to your google account which includes email, google meets, drive/other apps.

I-ready: This is a county-wide program that offers your child math and reading instruction on their level. They need to login daily.

RapidIdentity (NCEdCloud): This will give you access to your CANYAS course assignments and schoolnet.
