I hope all of you are enjoying a wonderful summer. Here at Norwalk Catholic School Jr. High and St. Paul High School we have been diligently planning for the return to school in the fall. Please see your schedule and the supply list from your teachers that are enclosed. Because of the necessity for us to efficiently use space this year, we may be changing room numbers for where your classes will meet. Check PowerSchool for the latest updates on this. You will receive a new copy of your schedule in homeroom on your first day back in school.

All students (including EHOVE Theology) will begin the year using a Staggered Start. Families with last names beginning with:

A – L: First day is Monday, Aug. 31. (These students will be off on Tuesday, Sept. 1.)

M – Z: First day is Tuesday, Sept. 1. (These students will be off on Monday, Aug. 31.)

ALL students will be in school on Wednesday, Sept. 2. If your household has more than one last name, please contact the office to let us know when your family will be coming to school for their first day. **After the two staggered start days, junior high and high school students will be on an A Day/B Day Block Schedule.** This will allow us to limit the number of transitions.

There will also be a link in the email to a Google form that you are asked to fill out indicating your acceptance of these policies and a Chromebook agreement. You will be notified via email once you have successfully submitted the form.
