Procedures for device, textbook, and materials distribution.

*Face coverings will be required and social distancing guidelines will be followed at all times during distribution. *

Students will receive a laptop computer and a folder containing the necessary login information, remote learning expectations, and helpful suggestions. This device will not be capable of accessing the internet for non-school related activities. **Parents must sign this electronic form prior to device distribution.**

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Remote Learning: Students will begin the year in "remote learning." Students will have the opportunity to learn along with their peers virtually using live lessons through Microsoft Teams. In this scenario, a teacher will be teaching a lesson to students that are logged in and present online. Students will utilize Empower as the learning platform for all remote learning content. Students will receive a brief Empower training at the device distribution. Parents will receive an Empower training during the first two weeks of school. Dates will be sent out with more information.

Attendance: Attendance online through remote learning is critical for success and absences will be treated the same as in-person absences. Students will be given Microsoft Teams meeting links for each class. The" live" link will only be accessible during the time that the course is regularly scheduled. A student is not required to log in to "study hall" for attendance. Attendance is required for all other courses. Students who have a commitment that would prevent them from participating in virtual class due to a doctor's appointment or pre-arranged family commitment, etc... would need to work with their teacher in advance to access any missed content or assignments for that day.
