Parent Conferences

It shall be the responsibility of each teacher to offer a conference to the parents of the children in his/her classroom. The purpose of the conference is to ensure the continued improvement of student achievement. Individual schools will make arrangements for such conferences. This conference should take place at least during the first three months of the school year at the mutual convenience of the teacher and parent. Teachers may have the option of scheduling conferences while their classes are involved with art, music, or physical education, if such arrangements can be made.

In addition, Open House programs will be scheduled during the first two months of the school year. In order to accommodate parents with children at different levels, Open House dates at the various schools should not conflict with those at the Mt. View Complex.

Parents and teachers are encouraged to schedule conferences at times other than Open House in order to facilitate a meaningful exchange of information.
