DRIVER'S EDUCATION Fall Session 2020

TO OBTAIN A DRIVER'S LICENSE BEFORE THE AGE OF 18, THE STATE OF MINNESOTA REQUIRES

- Completion of 30 hours of Classroom Training
- Completion of six hours of Behind the Wheel Training

These are both offered at the Senior High School. You may enroll by paying the \$300.00 fee in the Senior High's Office at 1420 4th Ave NW, East Grand Forks, MN. There will be NO refunds should a student fail or drop out of the Driver Education program.

Driver Education Fee: \$300.00 includes 30 hours classroom and 6 hours of Behind the Wheel training

Class Times: 7:30 – 8:20 am - In school or on zoom depending on your class schedule

Class Days: Sept: 9-11, 14-17, 21-24, 28-30, Oct: 1, 5-8, 12-14, 19-22, 26-29 and Nov: 2-5

Test Day: TBD: As of right now tests will be offered in Bemidji, MN.

Limit: 30 students per session. Max 15 Green students and 15 Wave students

In order to test: STUDENTS MUST PRESENT TO THE EXAMINER A CERTIFIED COPY OF THEIR BIRTH

CERTIFICATE AND SOCIAL SECURITY CARD (NOT LAMINATED)

Effective January 1, 2015, every driver under the age of 18 who completes behind the wheel instruction and is testing for a provisional driver's license must submit a driving log. Parents/guardians have two options regarding the driving log:

- Complete a supplemental parent class provided by a driver education program approved in Minnesota, and then submit a supervised driving log showing the student has completed at least 40 hours of supervised driving, 15 hours of which are nighttime hours; OR
- If the parent/guardian does not complete the supplemental parent class, the driving log must show that the student has completed at least 50 hours of supervised driving, 15 of which are nighttime hours.

The optional parent class will be held by Driver's Education Instructor, Dane Kjono at a date TBD.

STRICT ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES: Students must attend sessions either in person or online via Zoom. If the student has more than 3 absences they will be removed from the session and they must pay again and take a later session. While participating on Zoom, students must have their camera on and focused on them to be counted as present.

BEHIND THE WHEEL INSTRUCTION: The instructor will contact the student to set up a driving schedule after the full payment has been received. If a student misses their scheduled driving appointment without prior notice, a \$35 charge will be assessed and the student will not be allowed to drive until the fee is paid.
