The RSU 3 Title 1 compact is a written agreement indicating how students, parents, teachers, and our community will work collaboratively to ensure each child reaches his/her highest potential.

- 4. Encourage their child to ask for help
- 5. Provide help and encouragement for their child to complete homework assignments
- 6. Communicate with classroom teacher regularly
- 7. Participate actively in their child's learning and the school community

Our Students Will:

- 1. Have good attendance
- 2. Be safe, respectful, and responsible
- 3. Ask for help
- 4. Come to school ready to participate in learning, explore ideas, and make appropriate choices
