- Students will have opportunity to zoom into each class they are enrolled, will have access to the class Canvas page, and can email or set up a time for questions if needed.
- Students will have a mentor teacher, which will be their Virtual Falcon Squad leader who will check on them, teach them their SEL lessons, as well as make sure the PCR student has had at

least one meaningful encounter with a teacher each day. This teacher will be the liaison between students and their teachers and HMS.

- Teachers will use a shared OneDrive file to document when a PCR student zooms into a class in real time which will also document attendance for that specific class period.
- Student assignments will be assigned and due as with any student who is doing the on-site learning. Using the Canvas app, PCR students will have their grades delivered to PowerSchool.
- Parents will be required to sign documentation that they vouch their PCR student has met the KSDE 6 hours of learning daily requirement. Documentation will be collected by each Virtual Falcon Squad leader the Monday following the week of school attended. Parents can fax, email, or deliver the signed documentation each Monday.
- Failure to produce documentation can result in requiring the PCR student to zoom the required school time 8:05 – 3:15 every day and can potentially require a truancy letter to the Ellis County Attorney.
