

# 2020 Guidelines for a safer return to school



## **Face Coverings**

Students, teachers, staff and visitors will be required to wear a face covering.



## **Social Distancing**

Classroom seating and all activities will be arranged to include social distancing whenever possible.



## Handwashing

Frequent handwashing and sanitizing will be taught and exercised.



#### **Disinfection**

Classrooms and building interiors will be disinfected on a daily basis, including surfaces and high-touch points.



## **Backpacks and Lockers**

Students will not be issued lockers. Personal belongings and school materials will be stowed in backpacks.



## **Water Bottles/Drinking Fountains**

Students will use water bottles to fill at contactless drinking fountains or sinks.



#### Restrooms

Students will be allowed access to restrooms as needed.



#### **School Meals**

Meal times will be staggered to help with distancing.



## **Transportation**

Students and bus drivers will be required to wear a face covering on busses. Seating will be assigned.



#### **Office Areas**

Plexiglass barriers will be in place to protect office staff, students and patrons when practical.



#### **Foot Traffic Flow**

Directional signs will be placed in classrooms, hallways and other parts of the building to help with social distancing.



### **Playgrounds**

Playgrounds will be open for recess and equipment will be sanitized regularly.



#### **School Visitors**

Only essential visitors and volunteers, as approved by the principal, will be in the school.



#### Respect

All students will be taught to respect these and other quidelines.
