*Items with an asterisk do not need to be purchased prior to restargin in-person learning at the school.

Required Items:

- *Backpack
- *7 spiral notebooks
- *6 two-pocket folders
- 1 package ¼" graph paper
- #2 pencils or equivalent mechanical pencils—quantity varies by need (12 per quarter recommended)
- *Zippered pencil pouch
- Pens—black, blue, and red (5 each)
- 3 highlighters
- *5 glue sticks
- *1 package sticky notes

Art Supplies (only for students enrolled in art):

- 1 spiral bound sketchbook
- 1 dozen Dixon Ticonderoga pencils
- 2 white erasers
- *(Optional, but recommended) 11"x 11"x 11" tote for cubbie
- *\$20 material and supply fee (payable in main office)(will not be charged during distance learning)

Optional items:

- *Three-ring binder with dividers
- Ruler
- Headphones/earbuds for use in teacher-directed Chromebook activities (personal electronic devices are to be put away and turned off during the school day)
