## 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Supplies



Updated: April 15, 2020

- 1) 2 large pink erasers
  - 2) Girls-1 box of baby wipes & 1 box of quart size Ziploc bags
  - 3) Boys-1 roll of paper towels & 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
  - 4) Tennis shoes to leave at school
  - 5) 4 boxes of #2 pencils with erasers (wooden pencils only-no plastic wrapped pencils)
  - 6) 2 boxes Crayons-24 colors & 1 yellow highlighter
  - 7) Pointed scissors-have your child practice with them
  - 8) 1 bottle 4oz white glue of any kind (not paste) and 3 large glue sticks
  - 9) A zipper pouch to hold pencils, crayons, scissors and small glue-NO BOXES
  - 10) 2 boxes of facial tissues to share with the class
  - 11) 12-inch non-flexible ruler showing centimeters and inches  
(no metal rulers-plain wooden ones are best)
  - 12) One (1) spiral notebook for library
  - 13) Head phones in a Ziploc bag with name on the bag
  - 14) One (3-ring) ½ inch white binder only with inside pockets and clear pockets outside
  - 15) 1 plastic folder with 3-holes for putting in the binder
  - 16) 1 plastic pocket folder for science
  - 17) Small pack of page protectors/clear
  - 18) 2 Clorox wipes
- No ballpoint pens/ No pencil sharpeners
  - The cubbies are 9 inches wide. Your child's book bag must fit.
  - Your child will need at least the pencils and crayons for the first day of school
  - Please have the following supplies at home for homework: **Crayons, Pencils, Ruler**

## **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Supply List for fall 2020**
