



Child Nutrition Virtual Learning Meal Options

The School District of Newberry Department of Child Nutrition provides breakfast to all students at no cost and will send home breakfasts to **all** students on Monday (Team 1) and Tuesday (Team 2) for them to enjoy on their virtual learning days. Lunches will be sent home on these days as well to students attending Community Eligibility Provision schools. These schools are 1) Boundary Elementary, 2) Gallman Elementary, 3) Little Mountain Elementary, 4) Newberry Elementary, 5) Pomaria-Garmany Elementary, 6) Prosperity-Rikard Elementary, 7) Reuben Elementary, and 8) Whitmire Community School.

Students enrolled in Mid-Carolina Middle, Newberry Middle, Mid-Carolina High, and Newberry High may partake of school lunch by utilizing our pre-order form. A link for Middle & High School Hybrid Students can be found on the districts web page www.newberry.k12.sc.us. Hybrid Lunch Order forms are due by midnight each Wednesday prior to Monday/Tuesday distribution days. The exception to this deadline is the first week of school. Week one orders can be placed up until midnight, Sunday, August 23, 2020. Applicable meal charges will apply to lunch orders.

Students enrolled in Newberry One e-Learning can also choose to pick up breakfasts and lunch from the schools in which they are zoned. Again, Breakfast is free for all students, but lunch charges will apply. E-Learning students must pre-order their meals by midnight on Sunday of each week and can pick up their meals at their zoned school on Wednesday, weekly, from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The order form is labeled Newberry One e-Learning Meal Order and is located on the districts web page www.newberry.k12.sc.us.
