

EXPECTATIONS FOR RIDING THE BUS

Masks are REQUIRED to ride

1. Go to your assigned seat and stay seated until bus comes to a complete stop. Must stay in seats for COVID-19 contact tracing.
2. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
3. Be courteous. No fighting, pushing or foul language.
4. No eating or drinking – Except water.
5. Keep books, bags and instruments out of the aisle.
6. Show Respect to others.

*2 strikes of students out of their assigned seats and they are off the bus for the semester.

Bus schedules and rules

Parents/Guardians: Please read over the following rules with your child(ren).

Student Responsibilities: The privilege of riding the school bus carries with it some responsibilities on the part of the student. Drivers are expected to keep order and discipline on the bus, but their major responsibility has to be driving the bus safely. Therefore, students are expected to assume the following responsibilities:

- Students are expected to abide by the same rules as in the classroom.
- Students must be on time. The bus cannot wait beyond its regular scheduled time for those who are tardy. Students must be at their designated stop, not inside the house. Please allow the drivers a ten (10) minute window. This window of time is necessary due to uncontrollable factors such as traffic and weather.
- Students are not to hang on sides of the bus and are not to hang their heads, arms, legs, bodies or hands out the windows of the bus.
- Loud noises can cause a distraction to the driver and are not permitted on the bus.
- Students are to obey all orders of the drivers and to show proper respect to the driver.
- Students may not exit the bus at any stop along the route other than their own. If it is an emergency, the parents must contact the transportation department or the school, and permission must be given to the driver to release the child to the parents with proper identification.
- Only 1 alternative stop will be allowed per family, including day cares.
- Students are not allowed to throw objects while on the bus.
- Students must stay in their assigned seat for COVID-19 contact tracing.
- Students should never stand in the roadway while waiting for the bus.
- The possession of tobacco products and alcohol is prohibited on the school bus.

Our top priority is the safety of all students. By observing these few simple rules, we should have an excellent school year.
