Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

There is no doubt in my mind that the 2020-2021 school year will be one to remember. School begins on *September 8th for all 9th graders only* and then the rest of the Senior High School will begin September 9th using the hybrid model. This means we will be having a GREEN day where students with last names A-K will attend in person and we will have a WAVE day where students with last names L-Z will attend in person. Families that have children with different last names have been assigned the same school rotation. On the opposite day, students will be required to check in with their teachers each hour in some way (very likely Zoom or Google Classroom).

Registration for all grades will look different as well. Freshman parents will be given a link to a powerpoint in their ParentVUE & StudentVue explaining all the rules and regulations of the Senior High.

Please make sure to go over these with your son or daughter.

If you need to see a counselor for schedule issues, this can be done on the following days by appointment:

9th graders--August 24th

12th graders--August 25th

10th graders--August 26th

11th graders--August 27th

Fees

- Fees can be done online using something called SchoolPay. This is a new system this year. There are directions in the packet as well as on our website on how to get started with it.

Attendance

- Attendance will be taken by teachers each day. Students are expected to be engaged and participating in school from 8:30 am - 3:17 pm each day. If your child is sick, please call the office at 218-773-2405 even if they are not in the building for school. For appointments, please call the school before school starts (or send a note) to let us know what time your student is leaving. Then your student can pick up a pass from class before class starts. ADDITIONALLY, when your student returns to school from the appointment, they must have a slip from the office confirming that they were at an appointment.

Online Grades Access

Parents and students can access their grades online via our ParentVue and StudentVue sign on features on our website or phone app. Make sure that the Parent uses ParentVue and Students use StudentVue. Students need their own for class assignments and other student specific information. If you need these, call or stop by the office 773-2405.

Lunch Accounts

Each student has their own lunch account. This number carries over from our other schools. New to EGF student's six digit ID number will be their password. You can deposit money into their account in the office or on SchoolPay. You can apply for Free/Reduced lunch accounts via this online link: www.LunchApplications.com OR you can access the application form on our website.

Course Fees

Students enrolled in an ART or SHOP class will pay a \$10 course fee to help cover the cost of supplies. You can pay in SchoolPay.

Extracurricular Activities

The Senior High offers many extracurricular activities. Our current Covid-19 pandemic has

curtailed some of these activities and the extent is unknown at this time. That being said, if your student is going to participate in an extracurricular activity, they must be signed up on our www.greenwaveactivities.com website. For athletic activities, they must be signed up BEFORE the first practice and we MUST have a current (less than 3 years old) sports physical on file at the school.

Event passes

The student season pass is \$25 and the adult season pass is \$50. These can be purchased at www.schoolpay.com and will be mailed out to you or students will get a special punch on their student ID. Keep in mind that Covid regulations will limit the number of people allowed at each game. Single game admission is \$4 for students and \$6 for adults. (not eligible for tournament games)

Immunizations

Minnesota requires that your student is up to date on their immunizations before attending school. Your child cannot attend school if these are not current or the proper waiver is on file with our school nurse.

Student Email Accounts

Each student is assigned a Google email. If you are unsure what your student email is, stop by the office.

Hybrid Rotation Schedule

See the label below for your student's rotation assignment. The "GREEN" schedule will begin in the building September 9th. The "WAVE" schedule will be at home on September 9th. 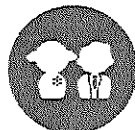

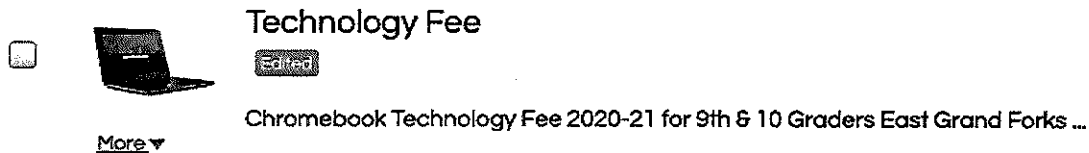

Chromebooks for 9th and 10th Graders

All 9th and 10th Graders are issued a Chromebook at the beginning of the year. They will receive their Chromebook on the first day of school IF you have completed the Chromebook agreement on SchoolPay. There is an option to pick up the insurance of \$20 or No insurance. You will need to register your SchoolPay account the first time you sign in (New this year).

-If you choose the option with insurance coverage, it's as easy as going into your ParentVue, looking at "Fees" for your 9th/10th grader and clicking on the balance due for the TECHNOLOGY Fee. It'll take you right into SchoolPay. Please complete the transaction.



-If you choose to not have insurance, you understand that your student will not be allowed to take their chromebook home. You need to go directly to SchoolPay.com, register, find the catalog and choose the NO INSURANCE-NO COST and complete it.
