NOTE:

- Both Level 4-Red and Level 4-Blue will cover strokes such as Front Crawl, Back Crawl, Elementary Backstroke, and Breastroke. In addition, Level 4-Blue will introduce Sidestroke and Level 4-Red will introduce Butterfly.
- Your child must be entering 5-year old Kindergarten in the Fall to begin lessons in Water Exploration. Class size will depend on the number of lifeguards available and there will be a ratio of two children per one lifeguard. Entry into the class will be determined on the first-come, first-served basis.

NOTE:

- Toddler season passes are for children not old enough to take lessons.
- Only members residing at the same address can be included on a family pass.

Diving Board Rules

- One person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
- One bounce is allowed on the board.
- Sitting on the diving board is not allowed.
- Go straight off the end of the diving board.
- Swim to the nearest ladder after going off the diving board.
- If a stunt off the board look dangerous to a lifeguard, the lifeguard may not permit the stunt to be performed again for safety reasons.
- When the orange cones are placed on the boards, this means they are closed to allow open swim in the deepest area of the pool.

NOTE: Please remember that all rules are in effect to protect the safety of all those who use the pool as well as to comply with State Codes.

Behavior Plan

- 1. First offence: verbal warning/reminder that their action is not acceptable.
- 2. Second offence: Child will take a break until the next guard rotation or when the guard has had a chance to discuss the behavior with the child.
- 3. Third offence: Child will be asked to leave the pool for the day after discussing their behavior with a guard.
 - *These are the general guidelines for rule infractions. Actual order and length of consequences are left to guard discretion based on the severity of the offenses.

Inclement Weather/Pool Closure Protocols

The pool may close under the following conditions:

- When the air temperature is less than 60 degrees F.
- In the occurrence of an electrical storm (thunder and/or lightning) the pool will remain closed for a minimum of 30 minutes, for the last occurrence, to make sure conditions are safe.
 - *If the pool closes due to inclement weather or cold temperatures, it will be posted on the Mondovi Swimming Pool's Facebook page.
- In cases where fecal matter and/or vomit are found in the pool water, we will need to close in order to decontaminate the water.
