School District of Mondovi Chromebook Acceptable Use Contract 2023-2024

Chromebook Care

- No food or drink should be near a Chromebook.
- Never leave Chromebooks inside a car where high/low temperatures can damage them.
- Do not personalize Chromebooks no writing, drawing, stickers, labels, etc. unless placed there by the school. Do not remove labels placed by the school. If your Chromebook does not have a label, it will be confiscated.
- Middle school students always transport and store Chromebooks inside their cases. Although
 cases are reinforced to help protect the Chromebooks, they are not guaranteed to prevent
 damage. Never carry Chromebooks while the screen is open nor hold the Chromebook by the
 screen.

Student Expectations

- Students will be provided with a charger and Chromebooks should be charged at home every night.
- Students should report any problems, damage, or theft immediately to their teacher.
- Students have no expectation of confidentiality with regard to any usage of a Chromebook or
 files that they create or store on district accounts. The school may view, monitor, and record use
 of student Chromebooks using monitoring software.

Damages and Liabilities

- Parents will be held responsible for damage (beyond normal wear and tear) to their student's Chromebook including, but not limited to: broken screens, cracked plastic pieces, inoperability of the device or charge cord, and damage to the Chromebook case.
 - Estimated Repair/Replacement Costs: Screen: \$70

Keyboard/Trackpad: \$30 -100

Liquid Damage: \$130 Chromebook: \$250

Charger: \$30 Case: \$25

- If the Chromebook becomes inoperable, the school has a limited number of spare Chromebooks for use while the Chromebook is repaired or replaced. If a student's device needs maintenance, they will need to fill out a maintenance form (online) and then exchange the inoperable device for a temporary loaner device while theirs is being fixed. This agreement remains in effect for any subsequent and/or temporary devices assigned to the student.
- At the end of the school year (or the last day of school for those transferring/withdrawing), students will turn in their Chromebooks and cases. Failure to turn in a Chromebook will result in the family being charged the full replacement cost. Unpaid fines and fees of students may be turned over to a collection agency. The district may also file a report of stolen property with the local law enforcement agency.
