Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Support Students and Families:

- Serve as initial point of contact for students and families in order to access services
- Identify problems and situations interfering with ability of children to be successful in education setting
- Advocate for appropriate access to schools for human services, behavioral health services and medical health services
- · Educate on available resources and supports available within the school and community
- Serve as a liaison between school, home, and community service providers:

Implement Screening and Assessment:

- · Mental health screening
- Social determinants of health (i.e housing, food instability, transportation)
- Provide comprehensive, diagnostic evaluations of students suspected of being emotionally impaired and collaborate with educational planning and placement committee in the determination of eligibility
- Serve as member of diagnostic team and educational planning and placement committees

Refer and Link students/families to needed supports and services

- · Make referrals for services
- Connect families/students to services
- Help families navigate system processes and protocol such as education, mental health, social services, human services, healthcare)

Develop Partnerships with Community Partners:

- Coordinate, community resources and supports within, and outside, the school system for use by students, families, and school personnel
- Foster communication between all parties

Support School Staff and Building Goals:

- Serving on school/district Whole Child team to assess building/district need, identify and develop strategies, and evaluate progress of whole child framework components
- Support schools in implementation of professional learning around whole child factors (i.e trauma, Youth Mental Health First Aid, Social and Emotional Learning, etc.)
- Meet regularly with building leadership and staff to review and address needs
- Participate in school improvement planning process

Assist in implementation of:

- Student Study Teams to assess needs of identified students, determine strategies to meet need, monitor progress, and evaluate outcomes
- Support implementation of MTSS tiered interventions along with positive behavior supports and integration of additional support services

Collect Data and Monitor Progress:

- · Collect data related to need, referral, outcomes, etc.
- · Assist building/district staff in collection, reporting, and use of pertinent data
- Document and monitor student progress
