Sports Guidelines

Due to COVID regulations, changes to this year's sports activities will be as followed:

- Volleyball and basketball games will not be open to the public to attend.
- Each player is allowed 3 tickets per home game and 2 tickets per away game to give to their parent(s)/grandparent(s) to come and watch them play.
- The public may attend the football games.
- There will be no student activity passes sold. If you have already purchased a student pass, you will receive a credit.
- Parents may still purchase a season pass.

School Restart Guidelines

Class Procedures:

- Social Distance (6 ft.) whenever possible
- Face coverings for teachers when in close contact
- Students must wipe down or disinfect traffic areas before leaving the room
- Wash hands and use hand sanitizer often

Passing times:

- Keep to the right in the hallway
- If waiting in line, give the person in front of you 6 ft. when possible
- Be fast in the hallways, do not waste time

Color Scheme:

- Blue-Green
 - * Face coverings recommended
 - * Full day 5 days per week
- Yellow
 - * Face coverings required
 - * Blended Learning:
 - Grades K-5 (Monday-Thursday in person, Friday virtual)
 - Grades 6-12 (2 days in person, 3 days virtual)
 - 6, 7, 10 Monday and Wednesday in person
 - 8, 9, 11, 12 Tuesday and Thursday in person
 - Everyone virtual on Friday
- Red:
 - *Face coverings required when in the building
 - *Full time distance learning

Ipads:

- Each student will be assigned a device
 - *Must take care of iPad
 - *Pick up in the morning and plug in after school
 - *Will be able to take home if we move to blended or distance learning
