Entering the Building	OMS Plan	OMS Response
Car Riders	Students will enter at the Enrollment Center doors. Two staff members will be on duty to monitor temp scanning. We request that parents not leave the car rider line until their child is cleared. If clear, students will go to the courtyard area or cafeteria.	If the scanner indicates a temperature of 100.4 or higher, the student will be directed to the designated isolation room. The nurse will be called to come to the student. Parents will be called to pick up their child immediately.
Bus Riders	Students will exit the bus and walk to a designated door at OMS to be temp scanned. If clear, students will go to either the courtyard area or cafeteria.	If the parent is not reached, the emergency contact list will be used.
Front Door Entrance	Guests/students will use the temp scanner upon entering the front door.
