Dear Collingswood and Oaklyn School Families,

Attached to this letter are several schedules to kick off the 2020-2021 school year remotely. You will find three schedules – one for Collingswood and Oaklyn preschool, one for Collingswood and Oaklyn Grades K-5 and one for Collingswood Middle and High Schools. While the schedules differ slightly to account for the ages and needs of the students, there are several overriding themes:

- **September 1 – 4: Introducing our Staff to The New Normal** - The staff will return to set up their instructional spaces, acclimate themselves with the new procedures, participate in training, and work together to share best practices in remote instruction.
- **September 8-18 (PS/elem); September 8-25 (MS/HS): Getting to Know You** - Remote instruction will begin on Tuesday, September 8 according to the attached schedules.
 - In addition, preschool and elementary school teachers will schedule 1:1 meetings with students and up to two family members. Weather permitting, we may schedule these outside to allow for fresh air and plenty of social distancing. These meetings will be available to all students whether you originally selected the hybrid or remote models. If you do not feel comfortable with a personal meeting, please let the teacher know. We understand, but wanted to offer this opportunity to everyone.
 - Middle and high school students will be invited to participate in small group, grade level orientations. For these purposes, students will be invited within blue and gold groups, by grade level. The Blue group will be further divided into Blue A and Blue B and the Gold group into Gold A and Gold B to limit numbers. You do not have those A and B assignments yet, but generally they will be by alphabet within currently assigned groups. We will get those assignments to you shortly. This is an opportunity for students to learn our new procedures and, for our new students, get acclimated to the buildings. We will invite everyone whether you originally chose the hybrid or remote model, but attendance is up to you and your child.
- **September 28 – October 2: Getting into the Rhythm** - We will remain remote and use this time to develop a rhythm. Since there will be a “remote” component of almost all plans moving forward, it is important for teachers and students to develop routines and set expectations.

As we move into October, we hope to begin transitioning students back into our buildings. We will keep a close eye on data from schools that have reopened around the country and listen to our health experts. The October schedule remains tentative as we will always put the health and safety of our students and staff first. A good rule of thumb is “plan for the worst and hope for the best.” Our October themes are:

- **October 5 – 16: Testing our Procedures** – Keeping our students safe requires many new procedures. During these two weeks, we will split our Blue and Gold groups into “A” and “B” cohorts and invite students back in one day a week. You do not have these subgroup A/B assignments yet, but they are forthcoming and will generally be by alphabet within the existing groups. With fewer students in the building, we will test our check-in procedures, our social distancing measures, and every other new procedure developed to combat COVID-19. Families who chose the full-remote model will remain remote.
- **October 19: The Hybrid Plan** – On October 19, we plan to move into the hybrid plan released previously. The “A” and “B” designations will disappear and the entire Blue Hybrid group will attend on Monday and Tuesday and Gold Hybrid group on Thursday and Friday. Wednesday will remain an all-remote day. Families who chose the full-remote model will remain remote. If data allows, we will maintain this model through the balance of the school year or until the medical community gives us the green light to relax social distancing measures.

Through both the September remote and planned October hybrid periods, instruction will be synchronous (aka “live”) with opportunities for students to interact with teachers daily. We know through practice and research that the most effective model of instruction in a remote environment happens in small groups. As such, you should not expect to see teachers “lecturing” for the entire class period. That is not what good instruction looks like regardless of where it happens. Teachers will record mini-lessons for students to watch (and re-watch, if necessary) and then work with both the full group and small groups to help students master the skills and content. Time will be built into the end of each day for additional student support.

Because the school day will be scheduled and teaching and support will happen during scheduled class time, attendance will be taken daily. Students are expected to attend class just like they were in school. If your child cannot attend class at the scheduled time, we will do our best to work out a solution. Please reach out to your building principal or administrator at the preschool/elementary level or your child’s counselor in the middle school or high school after September 1. Each situation will be different and, working with the teachers, we will design a solution that works.

We remain committed to getting our students with specific learning needs back into our buildings as quickly and safely as possible. As such, we will begin scheduling our special needs students (those students with the highest needs first) and our English Language Learners to return to our buildings, safely, before the planned return for all students in October. Related services (OT, PT, Speech, etc.) will also be scheduled. These schedules will be individualized and implemented incrementally. A member of our school community will be in touch with you to work out an appropriate schedule.

Finally, our teachers will work with each of their classes to establish “remote classroom norms.” These norms are important as they help staff and students build relationships in our classrooms. The quality of those relationships will determine success this school year. Below, you will find some universal best practices for preparing your children to begin the school year remotely:

- Establish a time for bed and a time to wake-up, as you would during a normal September

- When your children wake up, have them clean up and get dressed to get ready for school (note: we may schedule a pajama day, but every day should not be pajama day)
- Provide a well-balanced breakfast to start their day
- Determine a workspace in your home that your children will use for school
- Support your children in giving it their best shot. One of our goals this year is to develop student “agency,” meaning encouraging students to take ownership of their own learning by asking questions and taking risks! This is new to all of us so help them focus on giving it their best effort and developing organizational skills in addition to the mastery of skills and content. View mistakes as opportunities to learn!

Below, you will find a few frequently asked questions. You may have many more. As I did with the original hybrid plan, I will develop a short video to explain the preschool, elementary school, and middle/high school schedules in an effort to assist our families. If you have questions after that, please reach out to your building principal or administrator. We understand this is not easy for anyone and everything is new. We thank you for your patience and flexibility and will continue to work to improve our plan and answer your questions. Until next week, when we will release further information about meals, technology, etc. and provide answers to additional questions, remember to always #BeKind.

Q: When will my elementary child learn who will be his or her classroom teacher?

A: Teacher assignments will be sent by August 28.

Q: What should I do if my child's Chromebook is not currently working?

A: Email studenthelp@collsk12.org right away. Someone will respond during working hours and determine next steps. Please do not wait until school starts to email.

Q: If school is remote or if I chose “full remote,” may my child still participate in a sport or activity?

A: Absolutely. These activities will take place outdoors.

Q: When should I expect to hear from someone about my child with special needs?

A: Staff returns to our schools on September 1. They will contact you to schedule the “Getting to Know You” meeting as well as to discuss individual schedules and needs.

Q: Will students eligible for Free and Reduced Priced Meals (FRPM) have access to those meals?

A: Of course! Students and families eligible for FRPM may pick up a week's worth of breakfasts and lunches from the Collingswood High School Cafeteria (tennis court side of Collingswood High School) each Wednesday between 12 noon -2pm and again between 4pm-6pm. If you are unable to pick up your meals at that time, please call (856) 962-5700 x1002 and we will try to work with you.
