Beginning of Year FAQs

Q. Where do parents drop off students in the morning?

A: Parents must drop off students at the front of the school, the entrance facing HWY 75, between 7:10 and 7:35. Students will get their breakfast if desired and report directly to first period. Students must be in classrooms by 7:40am.

Q. Are there any new procedures this year I need to be aware of?

1. All students arriving to campus will have their temp checked prior to entering the building. If a student has a temperature of 100.4 or greater, they will need to be picked up from campus.
2. Visitors to campus will not be permitted unless prior arrangements have been made.
3. The campus will not be receiving any deliveries for students during the school day. (This includes lunch deliveries)

Q: Where do Parents pick up students?

A: Parents will pick up car riders in the afternoon on the bus ramp from 2:10pm - 2:40pm.

11th/ 12th grade will be released at 2:10pm

9th grade will be released at 2:20pm

10th grade will be released at 2:25pm

Q: Did the high school's daily schedule change for 2020-21?

A: Yes, Teachers will be in class providing instruction/remediation beginning at 7:10. 7th period will now end at 2:10pm; 2:10-2:45 teachers will be providing UIL coaching for UIL academics, remediation and study hall during this time.

Q: Where does my student go on the first day?

A: All students should report to their scheduled 1st period class.

Q: What school supplies does my student need?

A: All students need to come to school with pens, #2 pencils (sharpened, if possible) and notebook paper. Each class will provide a syllabus that will include a supply list for the class given on the first day of school.

Q: When will my student get their class schedule?

A: Official class schedules will be available through parent portal by Friday 8/21 3:00pm. If online enrollment has not been completed students will not have classes scheduled.

Q: What if my student is driving to school? How do they get a parking pass?

A: Parking passes can be purchased from the high school office. Students will need to bring a copy of current insurance, license plate#, copy of valid driver's license. Student will be given 10 days from the start of school to have their vehicle registered with the office. For more details refer to online handbook or contact the HS office.

Q: Will we have lockers this year?

A: No, students will not have access to lockers. In an effort to reduce student contact in the hallways we will not issue lockers and there will be less time between classes. Most textbook resources will be available through each students' NWISD digital account.
