Blaine Elementary/Middle School

<p>What should a student do to start their day, virtually, on August 26th? Specifically, is there an initial “door” that the student must enter? Google Classroom? Google Meet? Other?</p>	<p>All work is posted to Google Classroom daily. Teachers are also using Google Meet for class meetings, etc.</p>
<p>Is there a specific time that the student needs to be online?</p>	<p>Teachers have specific times that students are to be online. Those were communicated during Readifest through a class letter. Teachers followed that up on 8/24 with Virtual Class meetings.</p>
<p>Are there alternate times? If yes, when? Or how does a student find those alternate times?</p>	<p>Teachers have communicated those times with parents/students.</p>
<p>How do they get their Google Classroom access codes for Day 1?</p>	<p>Those were sent home during Readifest. They may also call the school if code is lost.</p>
<p>What happens if a student does not have Internet?</p>	<p>All books were sent home to students. Teachers are working individually with families to be flexible with those families. We have offered use of our parking lot and given those parents chromebooks to download and upload work at school.</p>
<p>How do they contact the teacher if they are having issues? Call school office? Email teacher?</p>	<p>Teachers are utilizing Class Dojo and email. They may also call the school for any issues that they might have.</p> <p>Front Office: 606.826.3624</p>
<p>Can a parent get help from the school secretary?</p>	<p>Yes.</p> <p>Mrs. Boggs and Mr. Jennings have access to all Google Classrooms in order to print assignments and provide support. We also have a list of all required classroom meeting times.</p>

Other?</p>	<p>Work is posted on Google Classroom daily. Students will begin their first day online in Google Classrooms.</p>
<p>Is there a specific time that the student needs to be online?</p>	<p>Elementary- No. Students can log on daily and complete the work.</p> <p>Middle- Yes, follow the schedule.</p>
<p>Are there alternate times? If yes, when? Or how does a student find those alternate times?</p>	<p>Yes. Students will view recorded videos, lectures, etc. at a later time.</p> <p>Communication will need to occur with classroom teachers.</p>
<p>How do they get their Google Classroom access codes for Day 1?</p>	<p>Codes were given out at Meet the Teacher. Parents/students may call school, if they missed the event.</p>
<p>What happens if a student does not have Internet?</p>	<p>Call school to work out alternate plans.</p>
<p>How do they contact the teacher if they are having issues? Call school office? Email teacher?</p>	<p>Email teacher or call the school.</p> <p>Front Office: 606.826.2351</p>
<p>Can a parent get help from the school secretary?</p>	<p>Yes. Mrs. Whitt can point students/parents in the right direction, if needed.</p>

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Louisa West Elementary School

What should a student do to start their day, virtually, on August 26th? Specifically, is there an initial “door” that the student must enter? Google Classroom? Google Meet? Other?	Students/Parents should use Google Classroom to begin each day. Work is posted daily. Schedules for Google Meet are available through Google Classroom or can be discussed with the teacher.

Are there alternate times? If yes, when? Or how does a student find those alternate times?	Alternate times will be scheduled with students individually as needed.
How do they get their Google Classroom access codes for Day 1?	These were distributed at Meet the Teacher. Parents may contact the school if they do not have this form.
What happens if a student does not have Internet?	Students will be given a jumpdrive. We are scheduling times to train parents on how to use them.

Other?</p>	<p>Students should expect to start school in google classroom on Wednesday at 8:10.</p> <p>Students can find their Google Classroom Codes with their schedules in Infinite Campus</p> <p>Videos/recordings will be uploaded for those that cannot attend at the designated time.</p>
<p>Is there a specific time that the student needs to be online?</p>	<p>Students should follow their schedule as it has been assigned to them. Students were given a copy of their schedule that is in IC. It has the google classroom class code built into it. They were also given a copy of their grade level schedule that has the time each class should take place.</p>
<p>Are there alternate times? If yes, when? Or how does a student find those alternate times?</p>	<p>We currently do not have alternate times for class, but students can log in to watch all videos at a later time.</p> <p>Louisa Middle is working on an ESS schedule to help students that are falling behind.</p>
<p>How do they get their Google Classroom access codes for Day 1?</p>	<p>Google classroom codes have been built into their IC classroom schedules. We do have a master list for those that call us, so we can give those codes out over the phone in a timely manner.</p>
<p>What happens if a student does not have Internet?</p>	<p>We will issue flash drives and chromebooks for these students, if we have enough Chromebooks.</p> <p>We are handing out Chromebooks. If we are short, we are adding students to determine alternate methods/hardware</p>

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	that we can use.

Email teacher?</i></p>	<p><i>We gave all students a list with contact information: School phone number, Facebook page, Twitter account, and Instagram account along with all teacher email addresses.</i></p> <p>Front Office: 606.638.4090</p>
<p>Can a parent get help from the school secretary?</p>	<p>Yes. Mrs. Meek will be happy to take calls from anyone needing help.</p>

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Lawrence County High School

Other?</p>	<p>Students will log onto their Google Classroom for first period. Teachers will begin introducing themselves to students, going over syllabus, and class expectations. The LCHS Expectations Video will be shown during first block, which is 2nd period.</p>
<p>Is there a specific time that the student needs to be online?</p>	<p>Students need to be online at the beginning of each class period.</p>
<p>Are there alternate times? If yes, when? Or how does a student find those alternate times?</p>	<p>I have spoken with students during the drive thru for Chromebook distribution. If a student is not available to be in class during that time they will need to contact the teacher to let them know if they have internet issues or appointments during class time.</p>
<p>How do they get their Google Classroom access codes for Day 1?</p>	<p>Google Classroom Class codes are printed on their schedules and on the student/parent portal in IC.</p>
<p>What happens if a student does not have Internet?</p>	<p>Students will utilize the Hotspot areas provided by LC Schools. If students need other accommodations they will need to individually contact the teacher.</p>
<p><i>How do they contact the teacher if they are having issues? Call school office? Email teacher?</i></p>	<p><i>If the students are having issues they can email the teacher, send a message through Google Classroom or call the school.</i></p> <p><i>Front Office: 606.638.9671</i></p>
