

## USD 460 Gating Criteria and Zone Summaries

### GREEN (LOW RISK)

- **K-12 On-Site Learning:** All students in K-12 attend On-Site. HES and HMS go to school from 8:00 am to 3:15 pm each day, and HHS students attend from 8:00 am to 3:25 pm each day.
- **Any student may choose Remote Learning.**
- Follow all Fundamentals (of Safety)
  - Stay home when sick.
  - Practice Social Distancing.
  - Practice good hygiene.
  - Wear a mask.
- Temperature checks will be conducted each day when students arrive at school.
- Stable groups will be established in each building and adhered to whenever possible.
  - We will work to limit the numbers of stable groups in our buildings each day, and there are occasions when multiple stable groups will be utilized especially at HMS and HHS.
  - HES: Classrooms and grade levels will stay together throughout the day.
  - HMS: RS Groups will stay the same each day; Core classes will stay the same each day; Encore classes will create multiple stable groups through seating charts
  - HHS: CREW will stay the same each day; All classes will utilize seating charts to create multiple stable groups in each classroom.
  - Before school gathering locations & lunch rooms will utilize seating charts to maintain stable groups.
- Visitors are allowed on a limited basis and must follow all Fundamentals of Safety.
- Building and the district offices are open.
- Playgrounds and outdoor spaces will be open with consideration given to group size at one time.
- In-person activities will be allowed with possible capacity restrictions, and all individuals should follow the Fundamentals of Safety.
- Spectators and audiences will be allowed with possible capacity restrictions and must follow all Fundamentals of Safety.
- There will be specific guidelines for transportation in school vehicles including face coverings, social distancing when possible, households seated together, assigned seating, use of hand sanitizer.
- Cafeterias will be utilized with the following guidelines in place: Hand washing or sanitizing, food distributed by kitchen staff, social distancing of 3 to 6 feet, limited cafeteria occupancy, use of touchless scanning for lunch codes, and cleaning between lunch rotations.
- Staff has full access to the buildings using keycard credentials at any access point.

### YELLOW (MODERATE RISK)



- **HES On-Site Learning (same as Green):** All students in K-4 will attend school at HES. The school day begins at 8:00 am and ends at 3:15 pm each day. We are basing the decision to maintain On-Site only for elementary students based on guidance from the [American Academy of Pediatrics](#) recommendations for students 10 years and under. This is consistent with guidance from KSDE, KDHE, and local public health.
- **HMS Off-Site Hybrid:** 5-6<sup>th</sup> graders will attend school at HMS. 7-8<sup>th</sup> graders will attend school at Cross Wind Conference Center (8030 N Hoover Rd). 7-8<sup>th</sup> graders should be dropped off at HMS each morning and will be bussed to Cross Wind. School begins at 8:00 am and ends at 3:15 pm each day.
- **HHS AM/PM Hybrid:** Approximately half of our 9-12<sup>th</sup> grader students will attend in the morning and the other half will attend in the afternoon. Transportation will be provided for students at the beginning, in the middle, and at the end of each day as needed. For AM students, they will attend from 8:00 am to 11:26 am each day, and PM students will attend from 11:56 am to 3:25 pm, with lunch served for all students from 11:26-11:56 each day.
- **Any student may choose Remote Learning.**
- Follow all Fundamentals (of Safety)
- Temperature checks will be conducted each day when students arrive at school.
- Stable groups will be established in each building and adhered to whenever possible.
- **Visitors are limited by appointment only with all Fundamentals of Safety followed.**
- Building and district offices are open.
- Playgrounds and outdoor spaces will be open with consideration given to group size at one time.
- In-person activities will be allowed and all individuals should follow the Fundamentals of Safety.
- **Spectators are allowed with limited attendance based on a percentage of total facility capacity.**
- There will be specific guidelines for transportation in school vehicles including face coverings, social distancing when possible, households seated together, assigned seating, use of hand sanitizer, and temperature checks.
- Cafeterias will be utilized with the following guidelines in place: Hand washing or sanitizing, food distributed by kitchen staff, social distancing of 3 to 6 feet, limited cafeteria occupancy, use of touchless scanning for lunch codes, and cleaning between lunch rotations.
- For HMS, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders will eat on-site, while 7-8<sup>th</sup> graders will eat at their alternate site location where they attend school.
- Food will be transported to the alternate site.
- For HHS, AM students will pick up their lunch prior to leaving school, while PM students will eat lunch at a designated location prior to going to class.
- Staff has full access to the buildings using keycard credentials at any access point.

### ORANGE (ELEVATED RISK)



- **HES Off-Site Hybrid:** K, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, graders will remain at HES. 2<sup>nd</sup> graders will attend school at the Hesston MB Church located at 610 W Randall and 4<sup>th</sup> Graders will attend school at Whitestone Mennonite Church located at 629 Crescent Drive. 2<sup>nd</sup> Graders should be dropped off each day at the MB Church and 4<sup>th</sup> Graders at Whitestone. Depending on precise data, we could consider remaining On-Site in Orange.
- **HMS Off-Site Hybrid:** 5-6<sup>th</sup> graders will attend school at HMS. 7-8<sup>th</sup> graders will attend school at Cross Wind Conference Center (8030 N Hoover Rd). 7-8<sup>th</sup> graders should be dropped off at HMS each morning and will be bussed to Cross Wind. School begins at 8:00 am and ends at 3:15 pm each day.
- **HHS AM/PM Hybrid:** Approximately half of our 9-12<sup>th</sup> grader students will attend in the morning and the other half will attend in the afternoon. Transportation will be provided for students at the beginning, in the middle, and at the end of each day. For AM students, they will attend from 8:00 am to 11:26 am each day, and PM students will attend from 11:56 am to 3:25 pm, with lunch served for all students from 11:26-11:56 each day.
- **Any student may choose Remote Learning.**
- Follow all Fundamentals (of Safety)
- Temperature checks will be conducted each day when students arrive at school.
- Stable groups will be established in each building and adhered to whenever possible.
- Extremely limited visitor access is available, only when necessary, and by appointment only.
- Building and district offices are open but are limited by appointment.
- Playgrounds and outdoor spaces are limited to the smallest number possible, such as a class or grade level.
- Only small group activities are allowed with no team travel, but practices may continue.
- There will be no in-person spectator or audience access with online broadcast through the Swather Sports Network when available.
- Staff has full access to buildings using keycard credentials at any access point.
- There will be specific guidelines for transportation in school vehicles including face coverings, social distancing when possible, households seated together, assigned seating, use of hand sanitizer.
- Cafeterias will be utilized with the following guidelines in place: Hand washing or sanitizing, food distributed by kitchen staff, social distancing of 3 to 6 feet, limited cafeteria occupancy, use of touchless scanning for lunch codes, and cleaning between lunch rotations.
- For HMS, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders will eat on-site, while 7-8<sup>th</sup> graders will eat at their alternate site location where they attend school. Food will be transported to the alternate site.
- For HHS, AM students will pick up their lunch prior to leaving school, while PM students will eat lunch at a designated location prior to going to class.



## USD 460 Gating Criteria and Zone Summaries

### RED (SIGNIFICANT RISK)



- **K-12 Remote Learning**
- All classes will move to remote learning.
- Food service will follow all procedures as determined by the Kansas State Department of Education with possible on-site pick-up.
- Building offices are closed, while the central office may have limited availability by appointment.
- Devices will be provided for each student to utilize at home.
- Staff will plan to work from home unless school administrators give permission to come to the school building.
