



ELEMENTARY LEARNERS (PK-5)

School supply boxes will be in their homeroom when your learner arrives.

Music will be held in elementary learning centers and P.E. will be held outside when weather permits. The commons will also be utilized when weather doesn't cooperate.

Elementary learners will not engage in distance learning on Fridays in our current learning model.

SECONDARY LEARNERS (6-12)

Lockers will not be available to secondary learners.

Learners can not store items in the locker room overnight.

Learners may have the option of showering after PE.

In our current learning model, learner attendance may be required from (11:00 to 1:30). Educators will have open office hours during this time. Learners will be notified, and the parent, if they are needed to visit with an educator on Friday. The first distance learning Friday will be September 11 and will take place every Friday, unless it is a scheduled day off. Learners will follow a designated schedule.

In our current learning model, learners in 9th-12 who do not have a class 1st or 7th hour do not need to be in the building. Learners must check in with the office when arriving and leaving. Once a learner chooses to leave the building, they may not re-enter the building.

Learners may obtain PE credit through participation in extracurricular activities. Please visit with Mr. Margerum if you want to learn more about this option.

ALL LEARNERS (PK-12)

Learners must report directly to their learning centers when arriving at school.

The library will be utilized as a learning center and will not be available.

Masks must be worn when entering the building, in common spaces, on buses, and areas in which learners can't social distance. If social distancing is not possible, secondary educators have the right to require masks in their learning center. Face shields are not an option as a replacement for masks.

Learners who are dropped off after the start of the day (8:00) must enter the south doors (Door #1).

Each learning center, gym, and the commons will be fogged at the end of each day by custodial staff.

If your family chooses to drop-off and pick-up your learner at school, you may still utilize the bus. Families will need to contact Carrie Petersen to notify the bus driver at least 24 hours in advance. For alternative pick-up options, please contact your bus driver.

Families will be notified via email if there is a positive COVID-19 case in their learning center and building.

Learners should stay home for 24 hours with no fever (without the use of medication) **and** improvement of symptoms-**whichever is longer**.
