December 11, 2019 Meeting Minutes

SHAC members introduced themselves and enjoyed a meet and greet lunch. It was determined a quorum was present to conduct the meeting. The meeting was called to order by Chris Bradshaw. There was a motion by George Frost and a second by Ashley Carlow to approve the minutes from the 10/23/19 meeting, all were in favor.

Nurse Susie gave an update on sickness at the elementary campus. She told the SHAC that new hand sanitizer pumps had been placed in every classroom and she is currently teaching hand washing to the elementary students. Mr. Bradshaw informed the committee that a Bully Awareness icon has been moved to the front page of our website and students have been informed of how to report. He also mentioned that our staff does required Child Abuse training yearly and that we will promote Child Abuse Awareness in April. Officer Grandy stated that she and Mrs. Neco are certified Stop the Bleed instructors and will train students and staff yearly. New bleeding control kits have been placed underneath each AED on campus. Mr. Windham stated that the MS-HS students will be participating in The Texas Youth Tobacco Survey on January 15th and the school will receive \$300. Mr. Bradshaw informed everyone that two new safety committees will be formed: Threat Assessment Team, Safety and Security Team. The teams will have an introductory meeting on December 19th and then will meet in January to start training. The meetings will be posted similar to school board posting. Nurse Neco informed the SHAC members that the staff wants another Biggest Loser competition. The competition will start in January and will run until Spring Break in April. Nurse Neco also stated that she's had one case of strep throat two weeks ago but has generally just seen sinus and congestion sickness at the middle school and high school.

Neco Jennings informed the members of a letter from the School Board notifying their intent to request a waiver from the TDA regarding the 2020 Summer Nutrition Program.

Nurse Neco reviewed the results of last spring's WellSat 3.0 assessment of the school Wellness Plan. She presented a Wellness Plan Report Card that is easier to navigate for a smoother assessment of the school's Wellness Plan. There was a first by Shannon Murphy and a second by Mary Copeland to add the Wellness Plan Report Card as an evaluation tool. All were in favor. Nurse Neco also gave recommendations on updating the Wellness Plan based on results from the WellSat 3.0 Assessment from last spring. The plan was reviewed. There was a motion by Joel Windham and a second by Debbie Johnson to approve the updated Wellness Plan. All were in favor. Nurse Neco will submit the updated plan to Mr. Bradshaw for the School Board to consider.

Shannon Murphy mentioned concerns about student safety and driving issues during drop off and pick up times and there was discussion among the members. Mr. Bradshaw welcomed her concern and stated that it will be reviewed within the two new safety committees about how to be addressed.

The next SHAC meeting will be held Wednesday, February 26, 2020, at 12:30 in the Administration Building. There was a motion by Alyssa Hawley-Twite and a second by Zane Williams to adjourn the meeting. All were in favor.
