

Attendance Procedures During Remote Learning

During extended school closures, Dyer County Schools CLP will be implemented. To ensure students are participating during remote learning instruction, student attendance will be determined by the following:

1. Students that have online access: The district will utilize software that monitors student activity in instructional programs. Students who are not logged in the required amount of time will be counted absent.
2. Students that do not have online access: The school will verify participation through the completed student work. The work must be returned in a timely manner. Failure to provide the completed work will result in an absence being recorded.
3. Students who are counted absent three (3) consecutive days for failure to log on or because of no contact by phone or email will be referred for a home visit.
4. Teachers and staff who specifically serve students with IEPs will closely monitor attendance and intervene and provide support as needed.

Determinations of excused/unexcused absences will be the same as determined under standard school operations (Board Policy JT).

Truancy and chronic absenteeism interventions will follow procedures as outlined in Board Policy JT.

Students, parents, and other stakeholders will be informed of these policies and procedures through the district website, individual school websites, and the student handbook.
