


Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Galatians 6:9 (NIV)


This year, SO MANY MORE people rejoiced to hear an even more important reading.

FAQ: Are you ever going to retire?

We are regularly asked if we'll ever retire -- yes, on April 30, 2023!

Several factors went into this decision.

- 1. Working for Wycliffe 40 hours a week has been a true joy. We love Wycliffe, but point #2 requires that we make some changes.
- 2. As Liz's health continues to deteriorate, she needs more help with basic activities of daily living. We're convinced God has asked us to be their support team so that Nick can continue working and the boys' needs are met in this multigenerational home.
- 3. Finally, in June of 2023, I can return as a member volunteer and we can receive any gifts that come in through Wycliffe as pension income.

Therefore, after prayer, consulting with advisors, and tons of learning and paperwork, we plan to officially retire at the end of April 2023 when I (Dorothea) turn 70.



The IRS requires us to officially step away from work with Wycliffe for 2 full months. Then I can return as a volunteer member, working up to 20 hours a week. That should balance our two main roles.

After April 2023, we can still receive gifts through Wycliffe as *pension income* to supplement Social Security. Wycliffe will send a letter to you, our financial partners, explaining the policy.

You all have been SO FAITHFUL as our prayer and financial partners -- THANK YOU! We realize that God may lead some of you to support other missionaries beginning in

May 2023. Along with you, we're thrilled to see many young people stepping up. But we will be extremely thankful for any of you who feel that God wants you to continue with us into our pension volunteer status with Wycliffe.
