Below are the current safety plans for our home events this week. We will have an additional post for the football game at Randolph Friday and for the volleyball tournament in Howells. Those will be posted Wednesday.

Cross Country Meet @ Complex, Thursday, August 27:

- Masks will not be required at the meet due to the extreme heat; fans are asked to keep distance from others.
- Masks will be required to order concessions.
- There is no admission charge for this event.
- If seated in the stands, fans must keep at least 6 feet between them and another group.
- Parents are required to stay away from the start/finish line area.
- There will be no awards ceremony; medals will be placed in team packets.

Volleyball vs. Crofton, Thursday, August 27:

- Masks will be required in common areas (Hallways, Concessions, & Restrooms).
- Masks are not required when seated—IF distanced—groups should be separated by 6 feet
- Masks will be available for \$1 if you do not have your own.
- Student section will be available for HNS 7-12 students only; students must social distance AND wear a mask to be in the student section. Students from other schools must sit in the regular seating section.
- Elementary students and younger must sit with parents.
- Admission is \$5 for all entrants (HNS students and children under school age get in free).
- Concession stand will have pop, candy, and pre-packaged items; no hot food; masks required to order.
- No food may be brought into the school.
- The varsity game will be broadcast at hartel.net.
- Fans will be required to exit the gym immediately upon the conclusion of the game. There will be no congregating in the competition area, hallways, or commons. Teams will exit the floor immediately after the game.
- We anticipate being able to handle all fans in our facility.
- Please do your part to follow this plan. Inability to follow this plan may result in crowd restrictions at future games.
