Dear Families,

Staff and students seem to have found their routines and back into swing of things after a week of school. We appreciate your cooperation and help getting students ready for school and making sure they stay healthy.

There has been a sharp increase in COVID-19 cases for Nemaha county over the past two weeks and the Southeast Health District is anticipating another spike this week which will send the county into the “orange category” (this would be considered Johnson-Brock Schools “yellow category”).

The health of our building is in great shape. We have not had the virus in our building however, we must be proactive with this virus and take necessary steps to ensure our building stays safe. This will mean we will be making some minor adjustments from our “green” status to “yellow” status.

At this time, we will not be reducing the number of students in our building and requiring remote learning. We will be implementing the following procedures beginning August 31st if the Southeast Health Departments dial goes to the “orange” category.

- Mask will be required outside of classrooms and when appropriate inside the classrooms.
- Breakfast will be a grab-and-go bag and ate in the classroom.
- Random temperature checks will be given throughout the day.

We will reevaluate the situation after 1-2 weeks of implementation.
