Dear Members of the Class of 2023:

It's that time of year again! Summer will soon be coming to an end, and the beginning of school will be here before you know it. Your teachers and administrators are excited to welcome back the Class of 2023. It is also important for you to participate in our extracurricular programs, and we encourage you to seek out those clubs and activities of interest to you.

I know that you may have many questions regarding the start of school, especially during these atypical times. We have created the HVCHS Return to School website (accessible via the school webpage beginning on **Wednesday, August 26**) that provides information about a variety of topics; please take some time to review it before the school year begins, and feel free to reach out with any questions or concerns.

We've created several ways to welcome new students to HVCHS, including small group building tours on August 31 and September 2, and a Freshman/New Student Drive Thru Celebration on September 3. If you are a new student, please contact the main office at 609-737-4003 to register for these events.

Your first day of school will be **Wednesday, September 9th**. Depending on your cohort, you will either attend school in person or remotely that day. If you are attending in person, please remember: students must wear their student IDs on a lanyard around their neck and have a copy of their schedule with them on the first day of school. Charged chromebooks should also be brought to school on the first day. Please be sure to review the protocols and procedures found in the student handbook and the HVCHS Return to School website prior to the first day of school.

Students should use the following building entrances:

- From 7:15 - 8:00 a.m., the bus loop doors and PAC doors will be accessible to students using student ID badges.
- The main entrance is accessible to students from 7:15-2:45 p.m. All students must use this entrance in order to enter the building after 8 a.m. There is an ID badge swipe at the main entrance.
- All students are expected to wear a mask, complete the pre-screening questionnaire, and have his/her temperature checked prior to entering the building. Please plan for minor delays as we implement these new procedures.
- Students who arrive late to school should report to the main office via the new main entrance to sign in.

School pictures for 9, 10, and 11 grade students will be taken on **Wednesday, September 9th** through **Friday, September 11th**, and **Monday, September 14th** during wellness classes and study halls. Information to purchase portrait packages can be found in the [CHS Virtual Backpack](#) on the CHS page of the district website. The money for portrait packages is due on the day that your photo is taken.

Although many classes have specific supply requests that will be shared during the opening days of school, we are also recommending that each student own a set of headphones/ear buds with a built-in microphone. In

addition, you will need a backpack or drawstring bag to carry your materials throughout the day, since lockers will not be used this year.
