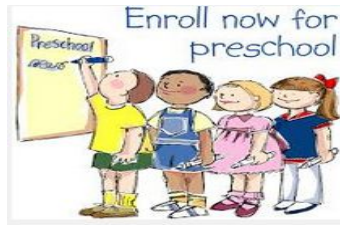


Preschool Registration



Registration for District 122's Preschool Program for next school year is beginning and will continue through the end of this school year.

In order to attend the District Preschool Program:

- 1) you must reside within the School District 122 area, and
- 2) your child must be at least 3 years old on/or before September 1st of the school year in which your child plans to attend preschool.

If interested in the Preschool Program, please complete the following steps:

1. Go to your home school (Columbus Manor, Harnew, Kolb, or Lieb) and tell the office you would like to register for the preschool program. Offices are open Monday-Friday from 8:00am to 4:00pm.
2. You will be given residency and registration forms. All forms need to be completed and returned to your home school.
3. When returning the forms, you must also bring your child's **original birth certificate** and **Proof of Residency documents**.
4. Once all your registration and residency information is complete, you will be called to schedule a screening appointment. Screenings will be held in the spring.
5. Children **do not need to be 3 years old to be screened**. We screen children as young as 2 ½ years old. Register Early!

Notes on Enrollment:

- SD 122's Preschool for All Program is funded through a grant from the Illinois State Board of Education. It is an at-risk preschool program that focuses on providing high quality educational programs for children who are determined to be at risk of academic failure, due to any number of reasons (determined through screening and a family interview).
- All children will be screened before preschool in the following areas: Concepts, Motor, Language, Self-Help, and Social-Emotional.
- Preschool is a half day program (AM or PM preference is considered but not guaranteed)
- Each classroom has a maximum of 20 children per class (3 and 4 year old children together in each room), with a minimum of one teacher and one assistant.
- Preschool is free, students attend school five days per week, following the district calendar.
