Metz Culinary Management wants to assure you that our primary concern is the **safety** of all involved. We are committed to the highest level of sanitation, safety, and service. You can expect the following from our highly trained, professional employees.

- Our team members will be temperature checked daily.
- Each team member will be required to wear a face mask.
- Our team members will practice social distancing during our shifts and service.
- We will require frequent handwashing.
- Our team members will work diligently on disinfecting tables and high touchpoints in the cafeteria and work areas.

In addition to the safety measures listed above, Metz Culinary Management will also will continue the use of deposit envelopes for the students and staff to assist with the safe method of making payments. Students and parents will have access to these envelopes and of course you can still make electronic payments, which is encouraged. The deposit envelopes are to be filled out and handed to a cashier in the cafeteria in the morning or in the cafeteria line during lunch. All deposits are to be in an envelope with child's name and ID number on it. The cashier will deposit those funds in the account before the start of lunch and at the end of the day and no change will be given, which will greatly assist with keeping physical contact to a minimum.

Our menu options will be prepared to the highest safety standards and will include a variety of fresh fruits and vegetables, whole grain breads, and an entrée, sandwich, or salad selection that your child will love while providing them with nutritious meal. We also offer our popular Craveables program, which provides a packaged lunch, similar to those you find in your grocery store's meat/deli section, but which meets all of the National School Lunch Program guidelines. Our grab and go program, Chef Fresh, also provides another great option for healthy, freshly prepared packaged salads, sandwiches, yogurts, smoothies, snacks, and more.
