20. Dress guideline violation. The dress guidelines focus on the following items (Act 835 of 2011):

Dress code applies to school issued extracurricular uniforms (Cheer, Volleyball, Basketball, Band...) during the school day.

a. Headgear

- i.No caps, bandanas or other headgear are to be worn or brought to any El Dorado School District campus or event. An exception is made for authorized school athletic caps or hats worn in the proper setting. Hats must be properly worn with bill facing forward.
- ii. Toboggans and/or hoods may be worn outside when the temperature is below 40 degrees Fahrenheit

b. Shirts and Tops

- i. Clothing, including but not limited to pants, leggings, jeggings, jeans, and tops are not to be so tight that they are revealing and/ or inappropriate for the school environment.
- ii. No bare midsections; no open-sided halter, strapless, or tank tops.
- iii. No see-through clothing
- iv. No suggestive or obscene pictures/ slogans nor any drug, alcohol, tobacco, or gang related logos.
- v. No revealing or low-cut tops.
- vi. Tank tops, muscle shirts, camisoles or any spaghetti straps may only be worn underneath an appropriate pullover or buttoned up shirt/ blouse.
- vii. Underwear/ under garments are not to be visible at any time.

c. Pants and Shorts

- i. No sagging pants or shorts.
- ii. No shorts more than 7" above the knee, as measured from the kneeling position.
- iii. No biking, leggings, or other tight shorts.
- iv. Pants or shorts with holes may not have holes higher than 7" above the knee as measured from a kneeling position.

d. Skirts and Dresses

- i. No hemlines more than 5" above the knee, as measured from a kneeling position.
- ii. No leggings may be worn with skirts shorter than the required length.
- iii. No revealing or low-cut tops.

e. Shoes

i. House slippers are not allowed. Proper shoes/ sandals must be worn.

f. Other

No rubber bands or sweatbands shall be worn.

No long, bulky chains, i.e. wallet chains, or bulky necklaces shall be worn.

No pajamas or sleepwear allowed

All clothing shall be worn as it is designed.

Any other items of attire deemed inappropriate and/ or disruptive to the educational process will not be allowed.
