I am asking that each parent/guardian, of a Macon County on-site student, read The Macon County COVID-19 Protocol for Decision Making plan. I ask that you pay special attention to the bullet points at the beginning of the plan. It is extremely important that you closely follow bullet points 1,2 and 3. (listed below). - **Parents are encouraged to take their child's temperature each morning and do not send child to school if temperature is 100.4° F or greater.**
- **Child should not be given fever reducing medication and sent to school if fever is 100.4° F or greater.**
- **If anyone in the household of a student or a close contact of student are awaiting COVID-19 test results, do not send student(s) to school until test results are received. Student's school should be called and notified as to why student is not at school.**
