

# Suggested School Supplies for High School

*Parents and students often ask the question what do I need for high school? There is not a definitive list as in prior years since each student's schedule is unique, however, the following list is compiled to offer suggestions to students as they prepare for the new school year.*

**Although there is not a specific school supply list by grade, the following items are suggested:**

- Backpack
- Lunch container or brown bag for lunch
- Water bottle
- 3 ring binders in a variety of colors. Larger subjects such as math, science and social studies may require a binder to organize work, notes, handouts, reference materials, lab reports etc.
- Dividers for the 3 ring binders
- 3 or 5 subject notebooks (single subject notebooks are generally speaking not adequate)
- Loose leaf paper
- Two pocket folders
- Flash drive may be needed
- Pencils
- Pens
- Calculator for math/science **(please refer to explanatory letter from the math department)**. Students in Algebra I need, at a minimum, a four function calculator; Geometry students need, at a minimum, a scientific calculator with sine, cosine, and tangent functions. All courses beyond Geometry require a graphing calculator. **TI- 84 series calculators are preferred for all courses.**
- Glue stick for projects
- Colored pencils and markers, crayons may be needed for some display work.
