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Circle USD 375 Event Spectator Guidelines

A participant is defined as any student athlete, cheerleader, manager, dance member, band member, color guard, or coach who is actively participating in the event.

District Stadium Events

- Football/Soccer: Home spectators will be limited to 4 per participant. Visitor spectators will be limited to 2 per participant. Venue capacity will not exceed a maximum of 25%.

Events in CHS and CMS Gymnasiums

- Volleyball: Both home and visitor spectators will be limited to 2 per participant. Venue capacity will not exceed a maximum of 25%.

Guidelines for All District Events

- High School participants will be issued event specific wristbands which they will be responsible to distribute to their spectators. Spectators must wear the event specific wristband on their wrist in order to purchase their ticket at the event and enter the venue. Wristbands must be worn throughout the event.
 - CHS admission: \$6 per adult and \$4 per K-12 student.
- Middle School participants will be issued vouchers which they will be responsible to distribute to their spectators. Spectators will redeem the voucher at the event gate along with payment.
 - CMS admission: \$4 per adult and \$2 per K-12 student.
- No USD 375 district passes will be accepted. This includes staff, family, individual, student, and senior citizen passes.
- No AVCTL or Patriot League passes will be accepted.
- Concession stands will be limited to pre-packaged items.
- Spectators who leave the event will not be allowed to return.
- Live streaming will be available for all home CHS/CMS football, soccer, and volleyball events.
- All spectator guidelines are subject to change based on Butler County Health Department recommendations.

Health and Safety Guidelines

- Health Screening: All spectators will be screened upon entry to the event.
- Indoor Events: Temperature checks will be taken upon arrival. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to attend.
- Mask Policy
 - Indoor Events: Masks are required at all times while inside USD 375 buildings.
 - Outdoor Events: Masks will be worn when entering and exiting the venue or when social distancing is not possible (restrooms, concession stands, etc.)
- Spectators should sit as family cohorts and social distance. Minor children will be required to sit with their family cohort group or be escorted by a parent/guardian at all times.
- Spectators will not be allowed near any participant groups.
- Only essential personnel are allowed on the field or court near participant groups.
