Re: Student Transportation

Dear Parents,

As we prepare to bring students back to the classroom, Madison Public Schools is in the final stage of implementing our transportation plan. Every eligible student will receive transportation. The ESC will be requiring all students to wear face masks upon entry and for the full duration of their travel time to and from school each day. Depending on the route capacity, it is likely that recommended social distancing practices of at least six feet of distance between riders will not be possible. Route information such as pickup/drop-off location, time, and procedures will be sent out upon verification from our provider.

Transportation will not be provided for any student who has selected the full-time remote learning option. As per previous district guidance, students who request a change from full-time remote learning to in-person instruction may have up to a 14 day waiting period to return to school. That request, sent to the building principal, should also have a corresponding request regarding transportation, which will follow the same timelines.

Eligible students may choose to waive transportation for the 2020-2021 school year. If you have chosen to waive transportation, transportation waivers must be completed which can be found on our district website under the Business Office, transportation section. Waiving transportation for 2020-2021 school year will have no effect on transportation eligibility for any future year. In addition, a parent may seek transportation reinstatement for the 2020-2021 school year upon request to the business office.

Subscription bussing will be suspended for the 2020-2021 school year in order to limit route capacity.

Detailed route information will be provided to parents as soon as it becomes available.
