Transportation	<ul> <li>Transportation for activities will be provided as bussing is available.</li> <li>The wearing of masks on activity buses is mandatory by all individuals on board the bus if cannot social distance.</li> <li>Individuals should socially distance to the maximum extent possible.</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  Masks will be required for all individuals on board on a bus at all times.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
Locker Rooms	<ul> <li>If an athlete does not need to use a locker room, they should remain out of the area.</li> <li>Locker room use should be limited to one team at a time.</li> <li>No loitering in locker rooms before or after practices.</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  • Locker rooms will only be available for teams that must store equipment other than personal items at the school. Individuals on these teams will be allowed into the locker rooms to limit capacity.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
Cleaning/Sanitizing	<ul> <li>General cleaning of athletic areas and equipment will be completed daily.</li> <li>Students are encouraged to have their own bottles of hand sanitizer for pre/post practice.</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  • Practice equipment should not be shared from one practice session to another unless it has been sanitized	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
Uniforms/Practice Gear	<ul> <li>Uniforms and practice gear must be taken home daily and washed.</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  Showers will be closed to use.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an

	<ul> <li>Practice uniforms/pinnies should not be shared from one player to another unless they have been washed.</li> <li>Athletes should make every effort possible to not use showers in the locker rooms and should try and shower at home.</li> </ul>		orange or red phase.
Water	<ul> <li>All athletes should have their own water bottles.</li> <li>Water bottles should not be shared from one player to another.</li> <li>Water bottles should be washed daily.</li> <li>Water stations or coolers may be provided with single use cups.</li> </ul>	Follow the same guidelines as the blue/green phase.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
Spectators/ Fan Attendance	<ul> <li>Spectators are asked to socially distance to the maximum extent possible.</li> <li>Masks are REQUIRED for spectators.</li> <li>Capacity limits in athletic venues will be enforced accordance with ND Smart Restart Guidelines or CDC Guidelines.</li> <li>No loitering or gathering with players on the playing surface after games.</li> <li>Gatherings/socials in school buildings will be prohibited before/after games.</li> <li>Spectators are not permitted to sit on the bottom row of bleachers.</li> <li>Spectators are not permitted on the field or court at any time.</li> <li>Spectators must vacate the facility immediately upon completion of the game.</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  • Attendance by spectators at events may be limited or eliminated in accordance with ND Smart Restart guidelines or CDC guidelines.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.

Concessions	<ul> <li>Concession menus will be limited to prepackaged items only.</li> <li>Concession stand workers are required to wear masks and gloves.</li> <li>Workers are encouraged to maintain social distancing to the maximum extent possible and should be staffed to help maintain distancing.</li> <li>Patrons must social distance when waiting in concession line.</li> <li>Tables will not be available for spectators to use.</li> </ul>	Follow the same guidelines as the blue/green phase.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
Practices	<ul> <li>Staggering of practice times is encouraged to alleviate having multiple teams in the locker room at the same time.</li> <li>Daily Attendance logs required by NDHSAA</li> <li>Athletes should plan to arrive at locker rooms no sooner than needed to get dressed and out to practice.</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  • Group sizes may be limited or may be divided by grade level and/or team.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
Ticketing	<ul> <li>It is highly recommended that patrons purchase activity passes if possible, to limit cash transactions.</li> <li>Ticket takers are required to wear masks, gloves recommended.</li> <li>Exact amount for cash transactions is recommended</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  Cash transactions will be limited to correct change only.	There will be no activities if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
Meetings (Team/Parent/Booster)	<ul> <li>If in person meetings are necessary, social distancing should be maintained to the maximum extent possible.</li> <li>Preseason meetings should have at least one parent present.</li> </ul>	In addition to the blue/green guidelines:  No meetings will be allowed in school facilities.	Any meetings held for groups need to be held in a virtual format only if a school(s) is in an orange or red phase.
