Tecumseh Public Schools is communicating with all parents of students who will be juniors during the 2020-21 school year to inform you that our school district plans to administer the ACT® test in Spring 2021 to eligible juniors as part of the state contract with the Oklahoma State Department of Education and ACT.

There is an opportunity for you to provide your thoughts and feedback on this matter at the next regularly scheduled Tecumseh Public Schools Board of Education meeting which will be held on Monday, September 14, 2020, at 6:00 PM at 1406 N. 6th Street in Tecumseh.

During the 2019-2020 school year, over 95% of high schools in Oklahoma selected the ACT as the test of choice. Our district believes that this is an excellent opportunity for all eligible juniors to take the ACT at no cost to them or their families. We do not anticipate any negative effects to your child's educational process from this decision.
