**How to Access NWEA
(MAP) Testing Remotely**

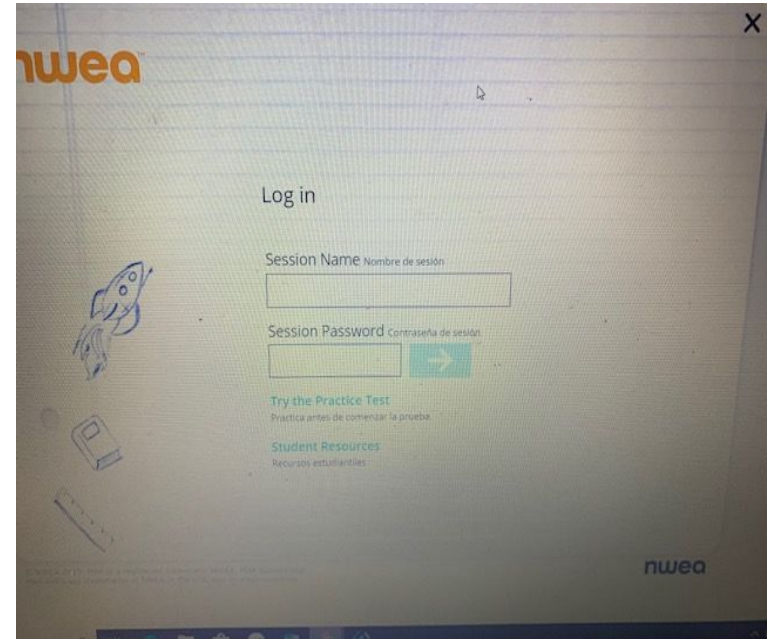

Getting Started

- Go to the NWEA website, which is test.mapnwea.org to confirm that you can get to the correct login page. It should look like the screen shown here. →

Please note:

- Prior to logging in, any pop up blockers will need to be disabled
- Make sure your sound is on prior to logging in
- Make sure your screen is no larger than 100%. If it is larger than 100%, you might not be able to see all the tools and directional pieces



Getting Started

- On the day of the test, you will log in to Google Meet to connect with your teacher. Your teacher will be giving the class directions, Test Session Names, and the Passwords to access the test through *Google Meet*.
- **Cameras must be on and students must remain visible to the teacher throughout testing.**
- **All microphones must be muted.**
- The teacher will be able to see students and answer questions during the test. If you have a question during the test, please send a message in the chat as all microphones should be muted during the testing time.



Tests

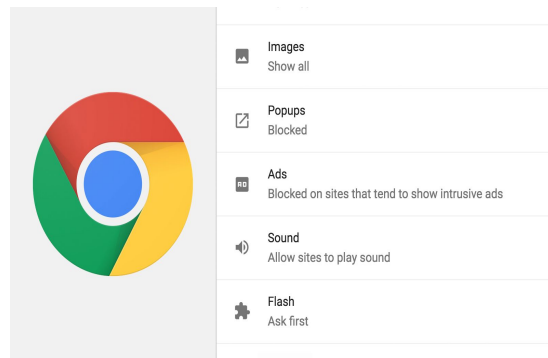
Students will take the following tests:

- **Growth Reading 6+**
- **Growth Language 2-12**
- **Growth Math 6+**
- **Growth Science 6-8**



Things to Remember

- Disable all pop up blockers
- Go to the test.mapnwea.org and from there, follow directions provided by your teacher through Google Meet
- Make sure your sound is on prior to logging in
- Make sure your screen is no larger than 100%
- This is an assessment tool to gather data on where you are currently at in the areas of Reading, Language Arts, Science, and Math. **Students must work independently on problems during the test.** If you have a question about the functions or tools of the test, message their teacher.



Test Taking Tips

- Students should take the test in a quiet environment that is distraction free.
- **Note** -this is an adaptive test, and each student will start with different questions, depending on how they ended their last test session when they took NWEA. The questions will adapt to how the student is answering and it's possible some students might take longer than others to complete the test, possibly even needing to come back to the test at a later session.
- Take your time and do your best!
