Seminole Public Schools is recommending the wearing of masks at school activities for students, staff, and visitors. Seminole Public Schools has always had the health and safety of student-athletes, coaches, staff, officials, administrators, parents, and patrons as our primary priority and throughout these uncertain times during the COVID-19 pandemic that means additional measures for safety are, at times, necessary.

When you attend events at our facilities, we ask that you follow the guidelines below:

- 1. Masks or face coverings are recommended for all participants, coaches, workers, officials, patrons, or anyone entering a Seminole Public Schools facility.
- 2. We ask that all patrons exercise social distancing within Seminole High School facilities.
- 3. Seminole Public Schools ticket sellers will wear masks and protective gloves.
- 4. Parents and/or fans need to remain in the bleachers and/or common areas provided for spectators. They will not be allowed to enter onto playing fields and/or courts before or after games.
- 5. While we believe sportsmanship is paramount to the development of young people, at this time, we recommend no hand shaking between opposing teams, both before and after games, to reduce contact as much as possible.
- 6. For participants, officials, and coaches, there will be no shared towels, clothing, shoes, water bottles, or equipment.
- 8. Locker rooms will be accessible to teams and will be disinfected before your arrival.
- 9. Only necessary personnel will be allowed in the press box or at the score table.
- 10. When traveling to and from away events, all Seminole coaches and students/athletes will be required to wear face coverings.
