RE: All Tonawanda City School District Students (K-12) Will Receive FREE Breakfast/Lunch!

Dear Parent/Guardian:

All three elementary schools at the Tonawanda City School District have qualified for the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) as part of the National School Lunch Program for the last two school years. Under this provision, participating districts and schools provide free breakfast and lunch to all students at all times. *The Tonawanda City School District is pleased to announce that the middle/high school now qualifies for CEP!*

What does this mean for me and my students who attend the school(s) identified above?

Free Meals! All students enrolled in a CEP school are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** for the **2020-2021** school year.

Do I still need to complete a CEP Household Income Eligibility Form?

Yes! All families must complete a form each school year to ensure this program's continuation. CEP Household Income Eligibility Forms are located on the Tonawanda City School District's Food Service webpage or at the Business Office (Door # 11).

Will MySchoolBucks account remain active?

Yes! Individual student accounts will continue to be maintained through MySchoolBucks to purchase additional meals, à la carte items, snacks, milk, etc. (i.e., items beyond standard breakfast/lunch).
