COVID-19 Gymnasium Protocols for Volleyball

The following protocols have been developed based on the most recent information from the NSAA, local DHM's and the CDC. All guidelines are subject to change without notice.

Capacity

- Based on the current DHM's, we will be able to use 50% of our gym capacity. Taking into consideration where each school will sit, we will be able to allow 200 patrons for FC and 125 patrons for the visiting school. The bleachers will be marked to help with social distancing.
- The visiting school will be given 125 purchase permits. Each person will have to show their purchase permit at the gate, and then pay regular admission. If you do not have the permit, you will not be able to attend the game. The visiting school can distribute these permits at their discretion.
- The home school will have 200 purchase permits. The VB team will be given a set number of permits to be distributed to family members. All remaining permits can be used by Fillmore Central students and patrons on a first come, first serve basis.

Striv

- Our plan is that we are going to be able to Striv all games (JH, JV and V) that are held at the high school. We are in the process of getting this set up.

PPE

- Mask use is highly encouraged when social distancing is not possible.
- All FC students will be required to wear masks.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available.
- It is highly recommended that non-participating athletes wear a mask/face covering when not participating.

Entrance and Exit Strategies & Occupancy

- All fans will enter at the main entrance (H-1). Fillmore Central fans will occupy the west bleachers and visiting fans will occupy the east bleachers.

Restrooms & Concessions

- There is only one set of restrooms at the high school, so our recommendation is that everyone wears a mask.
- We only have one concession stand. We ask that everyone do their best to social distance while in line, and we recommend the use of a face covering while in line.
- All water fountains will be locked, however, bottle filling stations will be accessible.

Students

- No Pep Band will play.

- No FC student below 9th grade will be admitted without a parent or guardian also attending.
- All FC students will be required to wear masks.

Postgame

- Spectators will not be allowed on the gym floor after the game.
- Spectators are asked to leave promptly after the conclusion of the game, and are politely asked to not congregate indoors.
- Athletes will not be allowed to come and visit with family or friends after the game.
